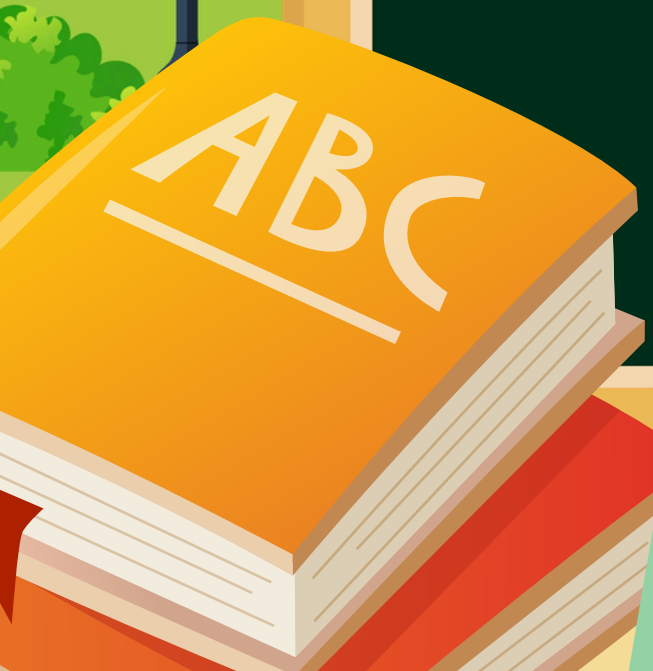

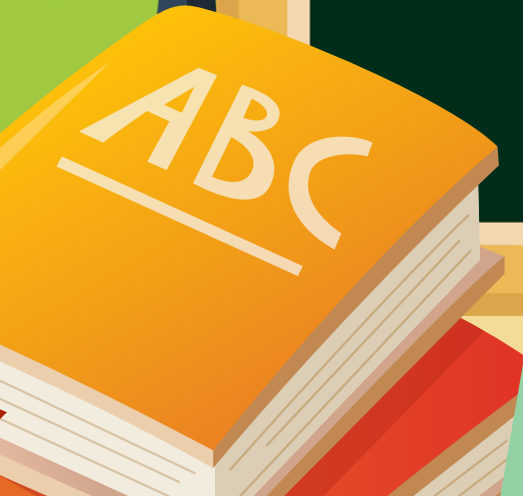




Daily Use English Sentences

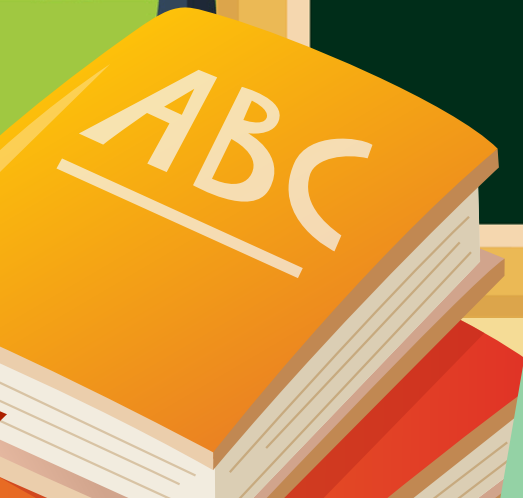




Basic Daily Use English Sentences

I am at home.

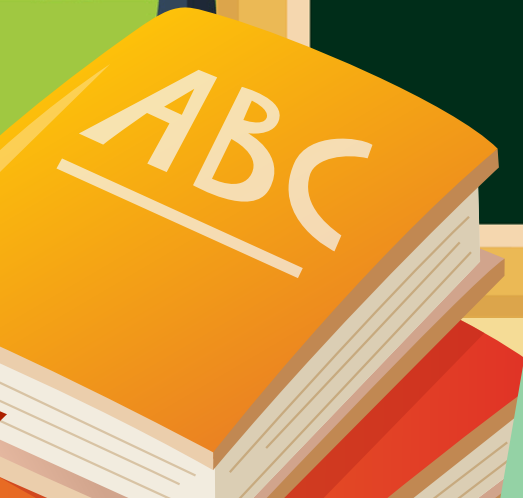




School Use Daily Use English Sentences

I am listening carefully.

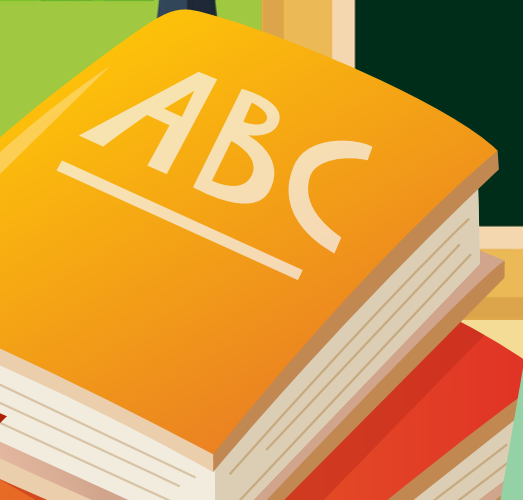




Daily Use English Sentences at Home

I am studying now.

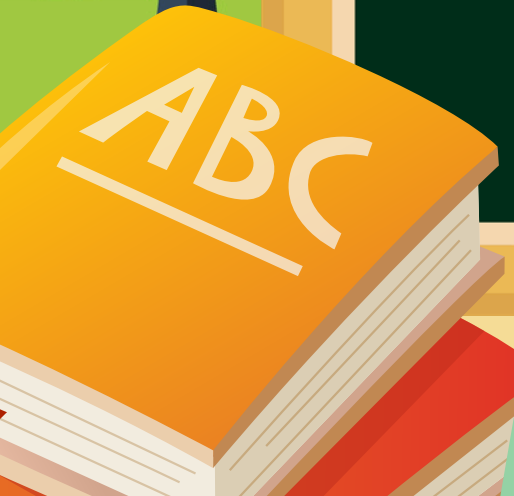




Question-Based Daily Use English Sentences

I don't know.

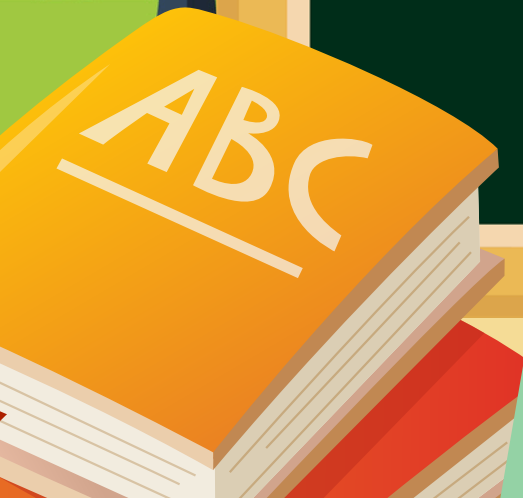
I understand.
